On Friday school was out and we made breakfast tacos for the JV and High school kids. It is so great having our stove so we can cook for our kids.

We took Steven (from the courts) to Eagle Pass with our team Friday night to minister. We spent the night after ministering until 11:30 pm. We rented a 15 passenger van and took half of our staff and people from our church and Steven. He had a blast hanging out with us and just being part of a family.

Today is Sunday and we brought 4 kids (5 counting Steven but he comes every Sunday now) from the courts to church. Afterwards a few of our staff took them out for lunch then back to their apartment to just hang out.

We had a meeting with Urban and they are going to add us on to their after school hot meal program. Don't know when that will start but we are so excited. We have been wanting to have food of any kind for them after school, but just couldn't manage it. We are just so excited to be able to have a hot meal for our kids after school!

That's about it for this week. Tomorrow we get to start all over again never knowing what the day and week will hold for us and our kids. Just knowing that it will all be great!
